Invasive Bush Honeysuckle (*Lonicera maackii, L. morrowii, L. tatarica,* and hybrids) Identification





Overall: shrub, usually multi-stemmed and in dense thickets **Leaves:** opposite, oval to football-shaped with rounded or pointed tips

Twigs: light brown or gray, hollow with brown pith

Bark: older bark is brown to gray and sometimes peels off in

thin strips

Flowers: white, pink, or yellowish fragrant tubular flowers with

long petals, bloom May-June

Fruit: shiny red berries, often in pairs
