

# Invasive Bush Honeysuckle (*Lonicera maackii*, *L. morrowii*, *L. tatarica*, and hybrids) Identification



**Overall:** shrub, usually multi-stemmed and in dense thickets

**Leaves:** opposite, oval to football-shaped with rounded or pointed tips

**Twigs:** light brown or gray, hollow with brown pith

**Bark:** older bark is brown to gray and sometimes peels off in thin strips

**Flowers:** white, pink, or yellowish fragrant tubular flowers with long petals, bloom May-June

**Fruit:** shiny red berries, often in pairs
