Black Locust (Robinia pseudoacacia) Identification



Overall: small to large tree

Leaves: alternate leaves with many oval, smooth-edged leaflets which turn yellow in fall

Twigs: green to brown with white lenticels and

paired spines

Bark: older bark is deeply furrowed

Flowers: pea-like white fragrant flowers in large

drooping clusters bloom in June

Fruit: flat pea-like pod with blackish seeds
